## **The Charities and Non Profit Organisations (Registration) (Guernsey) Law, 2008**

Thank you for your application form for registration as a Guernsey Registered Charity.

I can confirm that the name of Bus Users' Group has been placed on the Register as a Guernsey Registered Charity and the reference number to be quoted in any correspondence in this regard is shown above.

You will be required to renew your registration in January 2010 and annually thereafter. A reminder will be sent out during December 2009 and you will have until 31 January of the following year to send in your renewal.

The income of the charity will be exempt from income tax in accordance with the provisions of section 40(k) of the Income Tax (Guernsey) Law, 1975, if and so far as it is applied to charitable purposes.

If the charity is in receipt of donations made by Deed of Covenant, the person making such payments would be able to claim tax relief on his/her personal income tax return.
